Dear Friends,

Greetings in the Lord Jesus Christ!

The whole Church was filled with joy this past year as we recalled the 2,000th anniversary of the Apostle to the Gentiles, St. Paul. We have feasted on his words, reflected on his wisdom and, hopefully, came to a greater understanding of the Universal Church through his travels and letters. What a beautiful image we have of St. Paul as one who shared the saving power of Jesus with everyone he encountered. He is a strong witness for all who listen to him as preacher, teacher and friend.

Our parish has been blessed by so many who came to learn more about this remarkable saint. It has been our privilege to welcome, as St. Paul did, all who desired to hear. We pray that people found a welcoming faith community and decided to linger a while longer among us to hear more. During this same time, we commemorated the establishment of our parish, July 8, 1959, with a Golden Jubilee celebration that continues even now. Without this collaboration, we would dishonor those who came together in faith as Annunciation Parish, lead by their priests, building up the Word of God. St. Paul knew that his very life depended on "running the good race" and so does ours.

For our part, we do the same and reach within and without our parish boundaries offering your goodness to those in need. Together I believe we continue to honor the Apostle Paul when we embrace the needs of others. FROM THE PASTORAL PLAN

CONSULTATION AND GOVERNANCE

All the faithful by virtue of Baptism are equal in dignity. The voices of all are prized. The faithful have the responsibility to listen to the promptings of the Holy Spirit and the right to speak for the welfare of the Church. Those who exercise the power of governance, in union with the Office of the Bishop sent by the Successor of Peter, have the responsibility to listen to and communicate with the faithful. Consultation and Governance generate the structures wherein the charism of all members are valued.

GOAL 1: SHARED LEADERSHIP (PASTORAL COUNCILS)

Given that through Baptism we, as the Church, are called to share in the mission and ministry of Christ (*Dogmatic Constitution of the Church #33*);

Given that Christ's faithful are at liberty to make known their needs, especially their spiritual needs, and their wishes to the Pastors of the Church and that they have the right, indeed at times the duty, in keeping with their knowledge, competence and position, to manifest to the sacred Pastors their views on matters which concern the good of the church (*Canon 212, §2, §3*);

Given that clergy, religious and laity are to be committed to strengthening the structures of collaboration, participation and shared responsibility in our parishes (*Called and Gifted for the Third Millennium-USCCB, p.18*);

Each parish within the Archdiocese of Santa Fe, to promote collaborative ministry, will have a Parish Pastoral Council that functions as a consultative body to the Pastor. The Archdioceses of Santa Fe models this effort through the formation, training, support and sustenance of an Archdiocesan Pastoral Council.

Given that the stewardship of the faithful provides the resources required for all parish life;

Given that pastoral leadership is entrusted with the responsibility to manage resources in order to serve and benefit the entire Body of Christ (*Canon #532*);

Given that accountability and integrity build trust and good will among the faithful;

The whole people of God of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe will support procedures that ensure all Archdiocesan and parish entities follow established financial management and reporting policies to respect and honor the stewardship of the faithful.

1. Each pastor will supervise, implement and adhere to established policies, norms and directives as stated in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe Parish Administration Manual provided by the Finance Department of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe.
2. All parish employees, volunteers and organizations will adhere to Financial and Administrative Archdiocesan policies (e.g. finance councils, internal controls, employer guidelines) as stated in the Parish Administration Manual provided by the Archdiocese of Santa Fe Finance Department.

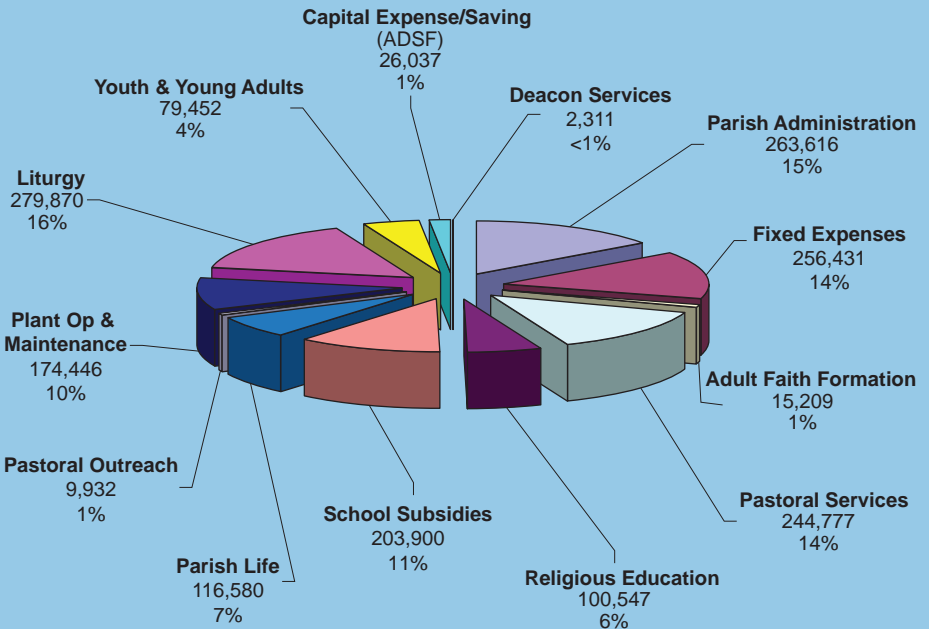

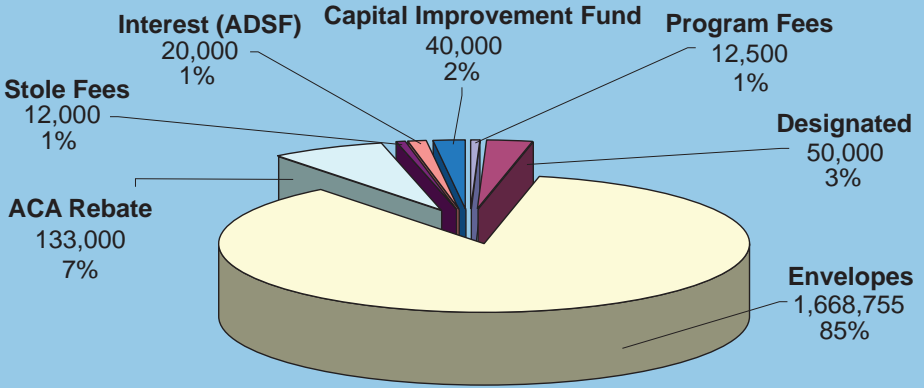

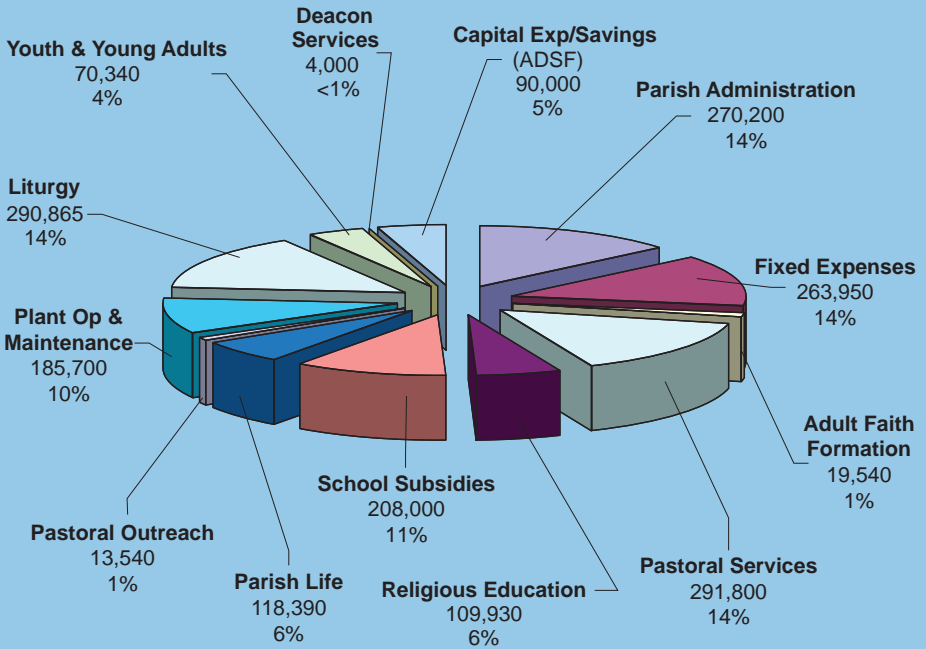

GOAL 4: CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

Given that Catholic schools perform a “specific pastoral function” as a mediator between faith and culture [31] (*The Religious Dimension of Education in a Catholic School, Congregation for Catholic Education*);

Given that our entire Catholic community benefits from Catholic education;

The whole people of God of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe will research, develop and implement strategies to make Catholic education available and affordable.

Annunciation School was blessed with increased enrollment for the School Year 08-09. Our school welcomed 62 new students from 44 families, to our school family, in school year 08-09. The school follows the Fiscal Year of the parish. As a parish, we support our school with a \$200,000 subsidy to help make Catholic Education more available to those who attend. We are grateful to all our parishioners who willing contribute to the subsidy through their regular contribution.

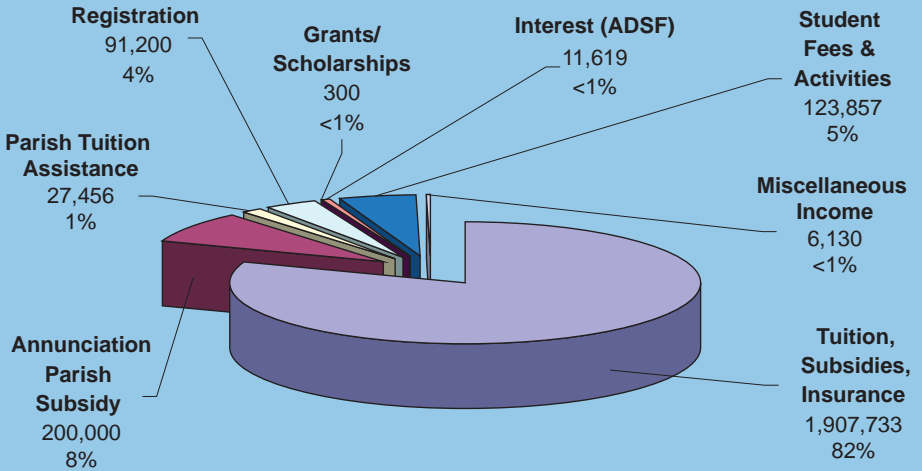

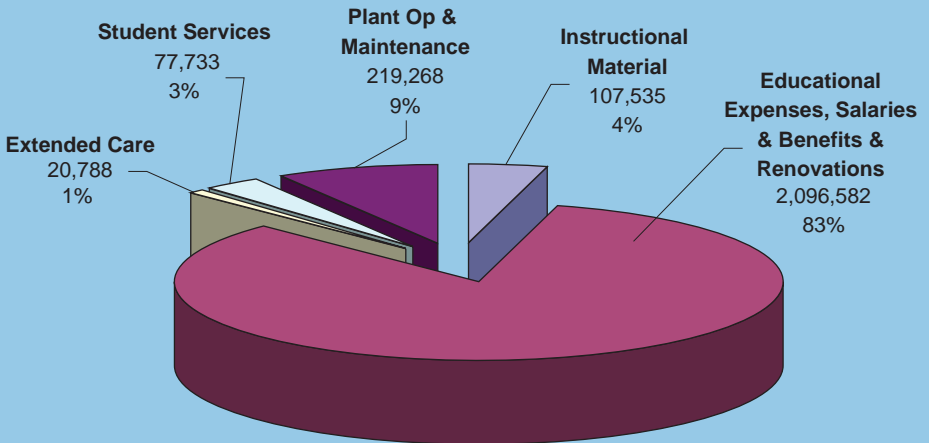

STEWARDSHIP AND ADMINISTRATION

Recognizing that the whole of our lives is a gift of God and is therefore at the service of God, the faithful respond to God's generosity by making a grateful return to the Lord that builds up the Church. As good stewards of God's gifts of time, talent, and treasure our policies and administration reflect justice, charity and respect with accountability at all levels.

GOAL 1: SHARING GIFTS/SHARED RESPONSIBILITY

Given that through Baptism, Catholics are called to be caretakers of God's generosity and are challenged to embrace stewardship as a way of life (*Stewardship: A Disciples Response; NCCB-USCCB, p.22.*):

Given that each parish community is part of the larger Church and therefore, called to generosity beyond parish boundaries (*Stewardship: A Disciple's Response; NCCB-USCCB, p.35.*):

Given that each Catholic community is blessed with particular gifts to be used for the building of the Kingdom of God benefitting the whole body of Christ;

The whole people of God of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe will promote the sharing of gifts among parishes (e.g. twinning) including personnel (clergy and laity), volunteer opportunities, effective pastoral practices, local traditions, material and financial resources.

On your behalf and by your generosity our St. Vincent de Paul Society is able to help those who find it difficult to make ends meet on an emergency basis. This year you provided in the St. Vincent de Paul envelopes \$65,138.63.



Our Community of Faith continues to grow: for this we give special thanks to God for the blessing of these new parishioners who, along with those already a part of our family of faith, make up the single greatest resource we enjoy.

This year 148 families joined our parish raising our registered parish families to 1960 of whom 1687 are envelope users.

We are blessed as a parish with very strong participation in and commitment to the ACA. Each year every parish is assigned a portion of the goal of funds which need to be raised for the support of Archdiocesan Ministries. Revenue received above our goal is returned to the parish in the form of a rebate. This successful program has allowed our parish many opportunities to designate and complete capital improvement projects at the parish level. The ACA is operated on an annual basis, 1 January - 31 December, while our ordinary budget cycle is a fiscal one, July 1 - June 30. While we count on the proceeds from the ACA we are equally as proud of the level of participation among our faith family. Each month, we report to you our progress as the appeal moves from goal to rebate by your goodness. Completion of any campaign appeal comes at mid year of our budget cycle and unlike our ordinary revenue, the Sunday collection, proceeds from the rebate are tax free for use in the parish. It has always been our custom to deposit the rebate immediately with the Archdiocesan Deposit and Loan and not within our parish operating funds. This provides a very clear picture of how we are doing and by being deposited directly in our savings allows us to garner the most interest until we use the funds for the projects identified to you when we begin each year's appeal. Thank you so much for your generous support of the Annual Catholic Appeal.
